



2011 Pride Festival Rules



1. Other than during normal festival hours, only authorized Staff, Security and Volunteers are allowed on festival grounds from the Thursday before and till the Sunday after the festival. During the festival hours, everyone must present the appropriate wristband.
2. Wrist bands must be worn at all times.
3. Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. *
4. Appropriate Clothing must be worn with in the festival grounds, the Pride Festival of Central PA Executive board will decide the propriety of attire worn in the Festival
5. No attaching posters, signs, placards, to any trees, poles, monuments, or buildings. *
6. Unapproved distribution of literature is prohibited.
7. No defacing, disfiguring, damaging or tampering with Park property. *
8. No person shall dig, remove, mark or deface any rocks, stones or trees. *
9. No person shall throw litter, liquid, or solid in any fountains, ponds, lakes or rivers. *
10. Place trash in provided receptacles. *
11. In case of an emergency, contact a member of the Pride Staff or the EMS.
12. No person shall be admitted under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs. *
13. No person shall be in possession of illegal drugs and/or alcohol on the festival grounds. *
14. Do not tamper with or attempt to cross over the security fence.
15. Everyone loves their pet, but unfortunately, we are only able to accommodate dogs the day of Pride Festival. Please leave all other pets in the cool comfort of your home.
16. All dogs must be kept on a leash and refrain from voiding urine and/or excrement in any part of the park. *
17. The taking of any photographic or video representations of festival attendees or activities is expressly prohibited unless consent is acquired.
18. Festival attendees may not enter the event with coolers, food, or drink.
19. Individuals and organizations participating in any Pride Festival-sponsored events must adhere to all Festival rules and regulations. No vendor or attendee shall have the right to express a contrasting or contradictory message to that of the event organizers. Festival organizers reserve the right to accept or refuse all vendor and parade applications, and to deny event entry and or eject any individuals or groups organizers deem to hold beliefs contrary to the goals of the event as expressed in Festival's Bylaws.
20. Events like this tend to draw protesters, who hover around the perimeter and attempt to clog the entranceway. Please do not engage with these people as that will cause problems for other guests who want to enter and enjoy the event. Silent Witness Peacekeepers will be acting as our welcoming committee, and would prefer that you not interfere with their assigned duties.

Any person(s) violating these rules will be immediately removed from the festival grounds without a refund.
